The public is invited to visit any of these sanctuaries. Take nothing but pictures, leave nothing but footprints.

Hunting is not allowed in any of these preserves.

CAUTION: Hiking through brushy areas involves some risk of picking up one or more deer ticks. Since the latter can carry Lyme disease, it is a good idea to make a careful inspection of one's body after any hike that involves close contact with vegetation.

You are welcome to hike in the preserve. We ask only that you **TAKE NOTHING BUT PICTURES, LEAVE NOTHING BUT FOOTPRINTS.**
